

Appalachian State University is seeking qualified students to apply for graduate school and graduate assistantships in Student Development.

**Outdoor Programs GA positions:
Graduate Assistant - 20 hours per week**

Position responsibilities may include the following:

Outing Center - Hire, train, schedule, facilitate meetings, and supervise approximately 25 Outing Center student staff and manage equipment rental as well as the registration database.

Media Marketing – Advise Outdoor Programs media marketing student club including the effective management of all promotional materials and social media.

Climbing Wall - Hire, train, schedule, facilitate meetings, and supervise approximately 40 Climbing Wall student staff and manage climbing facility, including inspection and maintenance.

Blue Ridge Parkway Corps – Recruit, schedule, and educate volunteers to provide service with the National Parks Service. Coordinate informational speakers for student volunteer meetings.

Challenge Course - Hire, train, schedule, facilitate meetings, and supervise approximately 20 Challenge Course student staff and coordinate, design, as well as facilitate programs.

Trips / Instructor Development Program – Recruit, educate, and manage the Instructor Development Program, including lesson planning, teaching, and conducting field trainings.

Bike App – Train, supervise, and schedule student staff. Coordinate tuning clinics and educational workshops as well as grant writing and program development.

Additional Responsibilities Include:

- Provide paraprofessional support in the daily administration of Outdoor Programs through work that is consistent with OP's mission and the educational and developmental goals of the Division of Student Development at Appalachian State University
- Participate in the design and facilitation of all staff meetings and retreats
- Serve as a mentor to OP student staff by modeling and promoting personal and professional development
- Assist with special programs, projects and events
- Attend weekly program team meetings
- Perform other duties as assigned
